Tempted To Do Wicked Things

1 Corinthians 10:1-13

10:1-6 Israel in the desert is an example for us, so that we would not be those who desire wicked things like they desired.

God's special presence, baptism, communion

Someone could partake of these things and not actually trust Christ.

This is an important thing to check yourself on.

If you don't actually trust Christ, trust Him.

If you actually trust Christ, don't desire wicked things, like people who don't trust the Lord.

10:7-10 Four events from Israel's time in the desert, where people acted wickedly, and they were killed in the desert

Israel's idolatry and Corinth's idolatry

Christians are to worship the Lord with everything we do in our lives.

Do you participate in things the ungodly participate in, that God would disapprove of?

Israel's and Corinth's idolatry which involved sexual immorality

Are you drawn to some form of sexual immorality?

Israel tried the Lord and complained against His leadership.

Do you get mad at God, because you think things shouldn't be the way they are?

Do you get mad at the messenger, whose message of God's truth is convicts you of sin?

10:11-13 Exhortation on how to respond

Make sure you stand firmly in Christ, through trust in Him.

If you trust Christ, don't give in to the temptation to do wicked things.

Trust the Lord in the middle of the temptation. Draw close to Him. Follow Him and His word. God will help you, so you can endure.
