New Bible Reading Challenge

The Minor Prophets in the OT

If you don't have a weekly reading plan, join others in the church in reading the minor prophets, in the Old Testament, starting with Hosea. Pastor Christian is planning to preach a couple of the minor prophets, but even for the ones he preaches, it would be good for you to read them at home on your own. Generally, read one chapter per day. It will only take about 5 minutes.

On YouTube, there is an animated video done by the The Bible Project that can help you understand each book as a whole. Go to YouTube, search "The Bible Project: The Minor Prophets." There is a series there with a video for each book. Before you get started reading each book, it may be helpful to watch the video.

If you would like a tool to help you with your quiet time, Bible reading and prayer, we have a bookmark that will help with those things. You can ask Pastor Christian for one.


