The church's responsibility to care for each Christian

"You all do not disregard one of these little ones."

Why might this happen?

We are too focused on ourselves.

We blame them.

That's none of my business.

God's care for them is the reason we should care.

God's care demonstrated through the angels

(Ref.: Hebrews 1:14)

God's care illustrated by the parable of the one stray sheep

God wants His disciples going after those astray.

The greater joy of finding (and bringing back)

God's care demonstrated through His will for them not to perish
