If something causes you to stumble

What is at stake? Eternal life vs. eternal hell

What should you do to the thing(s) that cause you to stumble?

What are these causes of stumbling, generally?

If something you want, some way you want to live,
some thing you like doing, is keeping you from trusting
Jesus, this suggests you should deal drastically with it.

Examples of things that cause people to hesitate to trust Jesus:

Sexual sin

Carousing and intoxication

Money and success

Religious upbringing

Intellectual pride

Generally, I want to do what I want

Application:
