Text sermon questions, during the sermon, to (602) 824-8030

A call to recognize signs that Jesus' 2nd coming is near (vv. 32-33)

The sprouts of the fig tree are a recognizable sign of summer.

Similarly, recognize the signs of Jesus' second coming.

"This generation" will be around until Jesus' 2nd coming (v. 34)

γενεά, "generation", primarily refers to a group of people

Jesus used this phrase "this generation" to refer to the Jewish people, who did not believe in Him.

Count on it, because Jesus' words will come to pass (v. 35)

Jews have a future.

Application of principles:

God's (Jesus') word will outlast the world.

God (Jesus) keeps His promises.

What is your response to this? Discuss it with someone today.

**Application questions for 6/7/2015 sermon
Matthew 24:32-35**

How confident are you that you will recognize the signs that Jesus' second coming is near, and why?

(This question may be unnecessary, depending on responses to the previous question.)
If you are confident you'll recognize the events, is it because you are confident that you have the end-time events figured out, or just because you think you'll recognize it when it happens?

Is it important to you, and your belief system, in some way, that Jews will remain around until the end of the age, and why?

Is there something in God's word - some promise, something that it tells will happen - that is important to you? Why is that important to you? And how much confidence to you have that it will happen?
