The reason for warning the Hebrews:

### **2:1 Pay attention to the message, so as not to drift away**

The message that was heard is the gospel of Jesus Christ.

A boating metaphor in "pay attention" and "drift away"

How I plan to approach the warning passages in Hebrews:

### **2:2 It is already known, disobeying God deserves penalty**

Them understanding the Law spoken through the angels  
(Deut. 33:2)

**2:3a We can't escape punishment from God  
if we neglect (ignore) the way of salvation He has given.**

This great salvation is salvation offered in Jesus Christ.

**2:3b This message of salvation came from Jesus,  
through the apostles, and God testified along with them,  
to confirm the message is from Him.**

The supernatural events serve to prove that the gospel message was from God.
