### Introduction to covenants

(old covenant ref.: Exodus 19)

8:6 *Jesus* is mediator of a better covenant, with better promises.

8:7-9 The old covenant was faulty and it was broken by Israel.

(ref.: Jeremiah 31:31-34)

Non-Jews are included in the new covenant.

### Better promises:

8:10 God's laws will be in His people, His permanent people.

In heaven we will never sin; we will obey God perfectly.

In heaven God will be among His people

(ref.: Revelation 21:1-3)

8:11 All God's people will have intimacy with Him.

8:12 God will pardon the guilt and forget the sins of His people

We are going to be able to enjoy the wonderful relationship with God, without any bad feelings between us.

(ref: Revelation 18-19)

8:13 The old covenant is obsolete
