9:23-24 **Christ now appears in heaven, in the presence of God the Father, on our behalf.**

Our lives can be presented as worship of God.

Our sacrifices: (Ref.: Hebrews 13:15-16)

Singing praises to God

Living good - obeying God

9:25-26 **Christ first appeared on earth to put away sin.**

The stuff that now happens in heaven is able to happen because Christ sacrificed Himself on a cross on earth.

9:27-28 **Christ will appear again to us on earth, unto salvation.**

Christ's appearances can change our judgment day.

(presenting our lives as worship before God)

Do you eagerly await seeing Christ come again to save us who trust Him?

If you think about this with any kind of regularity, what causes you to think about it, and what specifically are your thoughts?
