Unity of the Spirit is important among those who trust Christ.

(ref.: Ephesians 4:1-4, 1 Corinthians 12)

By the power of the Spirit, be humble, considerate, patient and tolerant.

We have the active presence of God among us in the Holy Spirit.

Being able to fellowship in the same church even though we differ on debated theological points, including spiritual gifts:

A certain worship style is not necessary for the Spirit to manifest His presence.

The Holy Spirit is involved throughout the process of salvation.

Although there are normal ways God acts, God is not bound to a set pattern.

Jesus was an example to us of being lead by God and empowered by the Holy Spirit.

A Christian can be characterized as being filled with the Spirit.
(see Acts 6:3, 11:22-24)

Want to be used by God, and give yourself to the works God wants you to do. (see Acts 4:29-31, Philippians 2:12-13)

Everyone should seek to be illumined by the Spirit when reading the Bible, to help understand the Bible.
(see John 14:26, 16:13-15, 1 Cor. 2:14-15)

The Holy Spirit can give us specific, situational guidance.

When we are making decisions in life, not only should we evaluate our options based on the truths of the Bible, but we should also seek the specific leading of the Holy Spirit, on what to do.
