4:32-37 The Christians were totally devoted to one another, led by the apostles, and God was working among them.

They met needs with generous giving.

They recognized the leadership of the apostles and trusted them.

Do you think you demonstrate such a commitment to other Christians?

5:1-11 A couple instantaneously die, as a result of lying about their commitment.

(ref.: Korah's rebellion, Numbers 16)

Their behavior was a threat to the authentic community of the church.

We should each take care in how we behave toward Christ's church.
