## Training the Next Generation of Christians

Acts 18

**Text sermon questions, during the sermon, to (602) 824-8030**

**18:1-3 Paul met Pricilla & Aquila, lived and worked with them.**

**18:4-8 The Jews definitively rejected, so Paul turned to the Gentiles in Corinth.**

Our responsibility is to testify about Jesus, not to force people to believe.

**18:9-11 The Lord told Paul to keep speaking in Corinth, that he would not be harmed, but people would believe.**

If you sense the Lord wants you to testify about Jesus to someone, even if it seems scary, you should do it.

**18:12-17 An instance of God seeming to protect Paul, in a trial**

**18:18-22 Paul took Pricilla & Aquila and went to Ephesus, then to Jerusalem, then to home-base in Antioch.**

Maybe an expression of gratitude by Paul to the Lord for keeping His promise

Paul left Pricilla and Aquila in Ephesus, and seemed to entrust the ministry there to them.

**8:23-28 Pricilla and Aquila taught Apollos the way of God more accurately, and Apollos became a better minister.**

Apollos was humble enough to be taught and get better.

Women are able to minister and be incredibly helpful in the church.

Discipleship happened, and leadership was passed on to the next generation - Paul to P&A, and P&A to Apollos. (ref. 2 Tim. 2:2)

We need to be learning, and then we need to teach others.

The next generation of the church is in our hands.
