19:1-7 Paul met some supposed disciples that he taught to believe in Jesus. They were baptized and received the Spirit.

Speaking in tongues happened in conjunction with three first time events in Acts. It showed the Spirit had come into true Christians.

It's possible to know stuff about Jesus and be favorable toward Jesus, and yet not have trusted Him as Lord and Savior.

19:8-10 Paul turned away from the synagogue and went to reason about Jesus in a lecture hall.

Would he have less opposition and more acceptance?

19:11-16 God performed unusual miracles through Paul. But some exorcists claiming the name of Jesus over demons got beat up.

We can't manufacture miracles and shouldn't try.

Jesus' name is not some magically effective proclamation.

19:17-20 Magicians believed in Jesus, confessed their practices, and burned their magic books. It was a great testimony.

We should change our former ways that are not Jesus' ways.

19:21-41 Worshippers of the goddess Artemis rioted because Paul had persuaded so many to faith in Jesus.

People of all different world-views and religions have apposed Jesus and have come to trust Jesus. We just need to share Jesus with the people and see what their response is.
