21:17-20a Paul told of the thing which God had done through his ministry, and they glorified God.

Paul didn't take the credit, but gave it to God.

The elders rightly glorified God, not Paul.

21:20b-26 The elders were concerned about the response to Paul by the Jewish-Christians who were zealous for the Law.

We now know about following the leading of the Holy Spirit.

It may not have been revealed to the Christians in Jerusalem yet.

If you don't understand being led by the Spirit, you should learn it and live that way. (Read, listen to sermons on Rom. 8:1-16, Gal. 5:16-25)
