Share Your Hope of Resurrection to Eternal Life

Acts 23:23-26:32 Christian Sanich. 5/19/2019

Text sermon questions, during the sermon, to (602) 824-8030

23:23-35 The Roman commander in Jerusalem sent Paul to the governor Felix in Caesarea, for a hearing.

24:1-23 Felix heard the Jews' case against Paul. Paul stated he had done nothing criminal, but used the opportunity to turn the conversation to hope of resurrection.

The Way (see John 14:6)

(O.T. ref. to the resurrection, Daniel 12:2)

Resurrection will happen for everyone. But only the righteous, through faith in Jesus, will be raised to eternal life.

24:24-26 Felix called Paul for a private conversation. Paul used the opportunity to speak to Felix about faith in Jesus. But Felix put Paul off.

Don't give up. Keep sharing as you have opportunity.

24:27-25:12 The Jews brought charges against Paul with the new governor, Festus. Paul appealed to Caesar.

25:13-26:9 Festus brought up Paul to King Agrippa, and Agrippa wanted to hear from Paul. Paul again used the opportunity to turn the conversation to hope of resurrection.

We can turn every-day conversations spiritual, and to Jesus.

The Jews were not hostile to Christianity because of the claim to future resurrection, but to the claim that Jesus had risen.

26:10-23 Paul testified that he had seen the risen Jesus himself.

Paul claimed Jesus, who appeared to him risen from the dead, is the Christ (Messiah-savior), which the O.T. foretold of.

We need to share these truths with people. They may not know.

26:24-32 Paul stated that he prays to God that all who hear him would have faith in Christ.

Pray for those around you to trust Jesus.

Be ready to testify, so they have a chance to trust Him.

Don't give up if the person doesn't believe in one conversation.
