1 Corinthians 1:10-17 Christian Sanich, 8/18/2019

1:10 The theme statement of four chapters: Urging no divisions, instead mend divisions

How can Christians do this mending back together? Have the same position on what is true. Have the same position about what is right and wrong.

1:11-17 Quarreling because of misguided allegiance to leaders

We should all be, in unity, following Christ, our Lord.

Christ was crucified for us. We belong to Him.

The church body, which Christ has supplied for us, should collectively minister to us. (further reading: Eph. 4:11-13)

Paul brought the gospel, not in wisdom of word, so that the cross of Christ would not be made empty.

We are supposed to be following Christ. To do that, what we need from teachers is truth about Christ, and truth about how Christ, our Lord, wants us to think and behave.

How might God be leading you to do something to mend division with other Christians?
