Take Off the Old, Put On the New

Ephesians 4:17-32

4:17-19 **Don't live like pagans.**

4:20-21 **You know better, don't you?**

4:22-24 **Live like the new person you are in Christ.**

Our thinking has to change. (see Romans 12:2)

Truth – what is real. Only God has the truth.

25-32 **Five examples of change** - take off the old, put on the new

Speak truth.

Don't you sin in your angry mood about others' sin.

Must deal properly with the sinning person.
(see Matthew 18:15)

Must deal properly with our angry feelings.

Do not give the devil an opportunity

Pray (ref.: Psalm 4:4)

Work hard and share.

Only speak words that build up, meet needs.

Do not grieve the Holy Spirit.

Become kind, good hearted, giving grace.
