Ephesians 5:15-21 by Christian Sanich, 5/24/2020

Context: Ephesians has been teaching, being in Christ, our actions should be consistent with our new nature. So we are not to participate in all the same things that non-Christians do. If you have trusted Christ, you have been fundamentally changed. So we are supposed to walk in newness of life.

5:15-17 Walk (live) carefully

Wise, not unwise

Make the best use of the time

Understand what the will of the Lord is

5:18-21 A new way to spend time with others

Not drunk

Drunk is a destructive waste of our time and lives

Fellowship instead, filled with the Spirit

Speaking to one another

Psalms - telling what God has done and is doing in our lives

Hymns - sharing biblical/theological insights with one another

Singing spiritual songs together

Giving thanks, in prayer to God and talking to one another

Being subject - allowing ourselves to be influenced by other Christians
