The Risen Reigning Christ Defeats Death

1 Corinthians 15:20-28

15:20-23 In Adam all die. In Christ all will be made alive. Christ was raised from the dead first. Those who are Christ's will be raised when He comes again.

All humans are in Adam, and will all die. This death is not just physical; it means separation from God.

Those who are in Christ will be made alive, to eternal life.

15:24-28 The living Christ reigns until He has defeated all His enemies. The last enemy to be abolished is death.

Death has reigned over humans from the time of Adam.

We, who are in Christ, can have eternal life, because death will have lost its power and will no longer reign over us.

God's plan to take back what was lost

The Son of God, the Christ, would take it back.

People to be God's people

Exclusive rule in the universe

If you don't trust Christ, you should. He is God's only plan to restore people to relationship with Himself.

Those of us who trust Christ, we should have confidence, that when Christ returns, we will be raised from the dead.
