The Undoing of the Lord's Blessings

Hosea 9:1-17 by Christian Sanich, 4/18/2021

There may be Q&A at the end as time allows. So note your questions.

9:1-6 Land, prosperity, temple, festivals, all to be undone, in Israel's figurative return to Egypt (which would be Assyria).

If you have seen the Lord's favor in your life, don't turn away from Him and His ways. Thank Him and keep following Him.

9:7-9 The Lord tried to call Israel to turn away from their sin and back to Him, through prophets, but Israel considered them fools and crazy, because they had gotten into such a bad place.

When a godly person warns you about your behaviors, or offers counsel about your life, you should consider seriously what they say, and consider if it's the way the Lord is speaking to you.

9:10-17 The great nation the Lord had built, would be decimated, and cast out from the good land that the Lord had given them, because they had not listened to the Him.

This was the Lord undoing the blessings He had given.

True good is bound up with the one true God. Trust Him. Listen to Him. Follow His ways.
