5:16a Confess your sins to one another & pray for one another.

(to God also, 1 John 1:9)

Benefits:

Can really pray for one another in a meaningful way

Spiritual healing (ref.: Matthew 13:15)

Getting right in relationship with God

The power of sin or temptation may just be broken

Addressing sin before it develops into a major illness

5:16b-18 Prayer of a righteous person has effect.

Find a person or two, who are trying to follow Christ and do what is right in His sight, to do this activity with.

5:19-20 If anyone strays from the truth and you turn them back

You help bring them to the Lord, like a priest use to in the O.T., for them to get forgiven of their sins.

P.A.C.E. = Prayer, Accountability, Counsel, Encouragement
