A Good Teacher of Christ

Colossians 1:24-29 by Christian Sanich, 10/17/2021

1:25-25 Paul was a suffering servant, continuing the work of Christ for the benefit of Christ's church (Christ's people).

There are more afflictions to be had before the end of time.

Paul was doing his part filling up afflictions, while doing what he was supposed to do for the church, filling up the word of God.

Any servant of the church, who is entrusted by God to teach the church, what they should be giving the church is the word of God.

1:26-27 The glorious mystery has been revealed, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. 1:28-29 Teachers of the church are (should be) proclaiming Christ - admonishing and teaching wisdom - so that every person may be presented complete/mature in Christ.

We are supposed to mature in Christ.

Good Christian teachers help us mature.

Teaching the word of God

Relating everything to Christ

Admonishing - stop doing

Teaching all wisdom - how to live properly

Paul worked hard, and the power of God worked in him. He's a model for every Christian servant, including teachers.
